



Trades Qualifier Work Experience Program Employer Declaration Letter

Apprenticeship and Industry Training

For an applicant to obtain certification in the Trades Qualifier – Work Experience program, an Employer Declaration Letter (EDL) must be submitted to confirm that the applicant is functioning at the level expected of an Alberta-certified journeyperson in the trade.

Please check your <u>Trade Profile</u> to see if an EDL is required.

The letter must be completed on company letterhead from the applicant's current or most recent (within 12 months of the application date) Alberta employer and include the following:

- Current date,
- Applicant's legal name,
- Applicant's Apprenticeship Industry Training (AIT) identification number,
- Applicant's trade name,
- Dates of employment/contract,
- Supervisor's name, certificate number and issuing province or territory,
 - o For a non-compulsory trade, the supervisor may be uncertified, and
- Employer (a person with signing authority) contact name, position, contact information (phone number and email address), and signature.

The applicant must scan or take a photo of this letter and upload it to their MyTradesecrets (MTS) account by clicking the Upload button in the Documents tab.

The information provided is subject to verification by AIT.

EMPLOYER DECLARATION LETTER – TRADES QUALIFIER – WORK EXPERIENCE PROGRAM
